

The Tartan

The General Grand Chapter Tartan is a tartan for all Royal Arch Masons. The colors are symbolic of the Chapter; Dark Red for the General Grand Chapter, Red for the constituent chapters and members; the four Golden bands allude to the 4 Capitular Degrees and the Blue, Purple, Red and White colors in the multi-colored bands together represent the banners found in the Royal Arch Chapter.

The Crest Badge

The General Grand Chapter Crest Badge (cover) has the Triple-Tau, Triangle and Circle as its heraldic elements. The strap and buckle circlet represent loyalty to the Royal Craft and the motto, "SANCTITAS DOMINO" translated is "Holiness to the Lord".

Official Registry

Our tartan was registered with the Scottish Register of Tartans, which holds the records of all known tartans.

KILT MEASURING INSTRUCTIONS

Measure from your TRUE waist ... just about the middle at the belly button or just below your belly button ... that is where the waist is and where you SHOULD wear your kilt. DO NOT wear your kilt at the hip waist. Measure around your middle and read what it says on the tape. The kilts are 24 inches long, but if you are shorter or extra tall they can be longer or shorter. Take a measure taking hold of it from your true waist and let it dangle down to about just above your knee.. MEASURE CAREFULLY— **NO REFUNDS ON KILTS!**
